Committee Boat - Channel 68. Please check in with Committee Boat, identify your vessel and the class you will be competing in, <u>wait for confirmation from race committee</u>.

There will be 10 Minute Count Down to start of race and a horn blast and/or flag drop at 1:00 p.m. for Schooner/Multihull/Classic start. At 12:55 p.m. the race committee will announce time at minute intervals, 5-4-3-2-1- Start.

2 Start Times: 1:00 Start - Schooner, Multihull Class, Classic 1:05 Start - Monohull

Start times may change due to number of entries or weather conditions Stay tuned to Channel 68 for your start time

Starting line is at Marker 15 and a line due west to the committee boat, Viking Sportfishing Yacht *After Hours*. The photo boat will be 36' Center Console Contender *Seaborn* with Captain Jesse Stavola and Video Photographer Tyler Nash. Engines must be turned off before you cross starting line.

Finish Line is between Red Marker #2 and Committee Boat at Sand Key. Pending weather conditions finish line may be adjusted - announcement before race start on Channel 68

<u>Call committee boat on channel 68 after you cross finish line and wait for race committee to</u> <u>confirm.</u> <u>Boats will receive an announcement on the VHF.</u>
